



Basic Knitted Hobo Hat

Materials:

1 skein heavy worsted weight yarn (ex. Andy's Merino, Chunky Alpaca, Organik)
16" circular needles in appropriate size for yarn
double pointed needles

Abbreviations:

K1 – knit 1 p1 – purl 1
m1 – Make 1 k2tog – knit 2 together

Instructions:

CO 64
Join for knitting in the round

Rounds

1-6: k2 p2

7: k8, m1, repeat 7 more times (72 st)

8: k

9: k9, m1, repeat 7 more times (80 st)

10: k

11: k10, m1, repeat 7 more times (88 st)

12-32: k

During following rounds, switch to double pointed needles when hat becomes too small for circular needles

33: k9, k2tog, repeat to end of row (80 st)

34: k

35: k8, k2tog, repeat to end of row (72 st)

36: k

37: k7, k2tog, repeat to end of row (64 st)

38: k

39: k6, k2tog, repeat to end of row (56 st)

40: k

41: k5, k2tog, repeat to end of row (48 st)

42: k

43: k4, k2tog, repeat to end of row (40 st)

44: k

45: k3, k2tog, repeat to end of row (32 st)

46: k

47: k2, k2tog, repeat to end of row (24 st)

48: k

49: k1, k2tog, repeat to end of row (16 st)

50: k

51: k2tog, repeat to end of row (8 st)

Cut tail and thread through remaining stitches. Pull tight and weave end back through.
