LEVEL: BEGINNERS AND EXPERIENCED CROCHETERS WELCOME

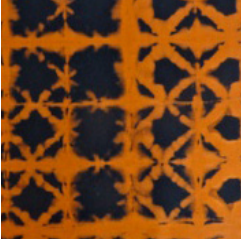

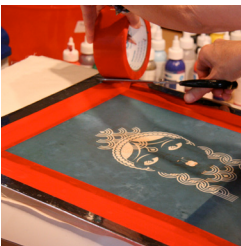
BOOKBINDING
