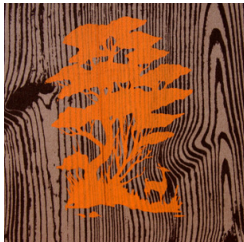
NEEDLE FELTED AQUARIUM

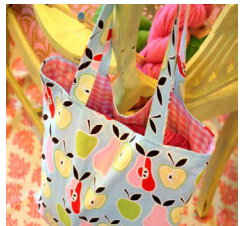
SOAP FROM SCRATCH
