

July 2011 Class Materials List



Zoo-illogical

- Required:
1. Aves Apoxie Clay ¼ lbs or more (required. available at The UCCO)
 2. A gaudy old frames (probably nothing larger than 8" x 10", but really that is up to you) (required)
- IMPORTANT: Needs to have some sort of backing! It can't just be a hollow frame we need it to have a backing to build our relief on.
3. Animal toys, doll parts, toy figurines, various body parts from models. The figures on trophies work really well too. (required)
 4. Variety of found objects that correspond with the size of the frame. These will be used on the frame as well as around the interior portrait. Could literally be anything. (required)
 5. Bits of ephemera, text, and other paper images.
 6. Paint Brushes (a couple small detail brushes, and some cheap brushes (1/2 inch to 1 inch in size) (required)
 7. Wire a couple of different gauges
 8. Basic Tools...pliers, scissors, (tools will be available to use in the studio)
 9. Paint (acrylic...preferably Golden brand...either fluid or heavy body will work)
 - a. Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold
 - b. Nickel Azo Yellow
 - c. Black (Mars or Carbon)
 - d. Titanium White
 - e. Pthalo Green (blue shade)
 - f. Dioxazine Purple
 - g. Van Dyke Brown
 - h. Paynes Gray
 - i. Quinacridone Crimson
 10. Sand paper or sanding sponge
 11. Adhesives.
 - a. Dap Kwik Seal for kitchen and bath -White. Should say paintable or water base acrylic or latex.
 - b. Clear Liquid Nails or E6000 (required)

Optional Materials

- a. Mica.
 - b. Transparencies with images on them
 - c. Mesh or bits of fabric, string etc.
13. Optional Paints
 - a. Interference Colors (blue, violet or any others)
 - b. Iridescent colors (Gold, Silver, Bronze, Copper, etc)
 - c. Micaceous Iron Oxide

Optional Tools

- a. Heat gun
- b. Dremel with cut-off wheel

Intro to Knitting

- Required:
- 1-2 skeins Lamb's Pride Bulky yarn (any color)
 - straight knitting needles size 10.5

Intro to Sewing - Tote

Required: • thread to match chosen fabrics

- 1/2 yd fabric for exterior of tote bag
- 1/2 yd fabric for interior lining
- 1/2 yd fabric for strap

Intro to Sewing - Pillow

Required: • thread to match chosen fabric

- 1/2 yd fabric
- your choice of poly, wool, or feather pillow form

Granny Squares

Required: • worsted weight yarn (various colors in the same brand)

- size g crochet hook

Sewing Camp

Required: • pillow case: 1/2 yard of fabric and coordinating thread

Tiers and ruffles skirt: 1/2 yard of fabric and two 1/4 yard cuts of coordinating fabrics, 1 yard elastic, coordinating thread, rick rack (optional)

mini pieced quilt top: 4 fat quarters and 1 yard of backing fabric, coordinating thread

Fat quarter bag: 1/2 yard of duck cloth, 1/2 yard of lining fabric, coordinating thread

Amigurumi Toys

Required: • size F hook (3.75 mm)

- bulky weight yarn (Lamb's Pride Bulky), multiple colors depending on project
- split stitch marker
- yarn needle
- soft stuffing material

Laminated Beach Tote

Required: • thread to match fabric

- 2 yards of laminated cotton
- 2 yards of nylon or cotton woven strap

Hemming Pants & Jeans

Required: • thread to match your pants

- 3-5 pairs of pants

Hand Bound Journals

Required: • up to 3 coordinating fat quarters for the book covers, spine and inside cover

Gocco Printing

Required: • 1 black and white, high contrast image (no larger than 3.5" x 4.5").

- materials to print on; t-shirts, fabrics, paper, etc.

Painting in a Day

Required: • Wood board size 8x8 in. • Acrylic paints of your choice • Mod Podge • Any additional mediums of your choice i.e. Pencils, erasers, colored pencils, chalk or oil pastels, chalk, etc. • any inspirational images/photo you would like to incorporate
