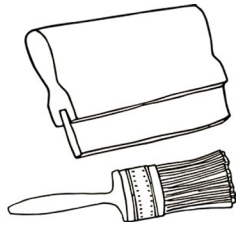

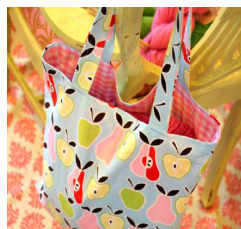
INTRO TO KNITTING
