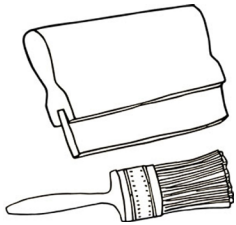

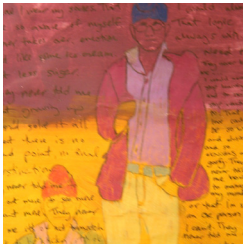
## PLUSH CHIMPANWEES

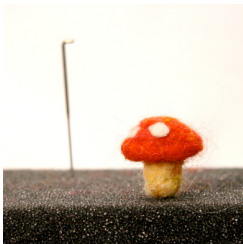
## HOT PROCESS SOAP

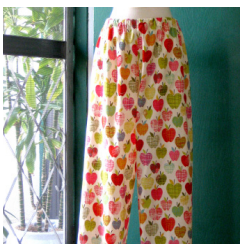
## INTRO TO SEWING
