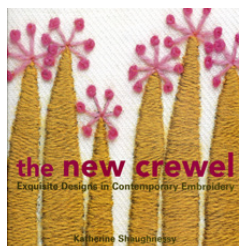
CREWEL 101

Each person has a unique inherent sense and power of creativity and the experience of SAORI weaving can be a unique self-discovery. Every piece of weaving, even with the irregular selvages, loose threads, and accidental skips of threads, shows the unique personality and beauty of the person who made it.

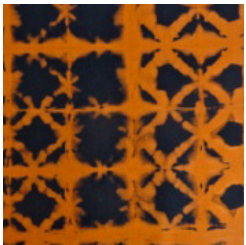
ATTACK OF THE MUTANT PLUSH BUNNIES
