

## November 2010 Class Materials List



### Crochet Pot Holders

Required: • Yarn kit available day of class for \$10, crochet hook size g (4.5mm),

### Love Stings Jellyfish

Required: • 1 skein Lamb's Pride Bulky yarn (any color) • crochet hook size g (4.5mm)

### Intro to Sewing

Required: • 1/2 yard cotton fabric (cotton or cotton/linen blend only), matching thread

Optional: • 16" pillow form

### Wee Wonderfals: Margot

Required: (please note: this is a 2-in-1, topsy turvy doll, one side of the doll is referred to as Dressed Down, the other as Dressed Up) • 1/4 yd solid color cotton or flannel for doll body • 1/2 yd cotton print for Dressed Down's dress • scrap of cotton print for Dressed Down's apron • 1/2 yd cotton print for Dressed Up's dress • 1/2 yd accent fabric for Dressed Up's waistband, collar and scalloped hem • 4" length of 1/2 inch wide ribbon • cotton thread • embroidery floss for face • 1 skein lamb's pride worsted weight yarn for hair

Recommended: • copy of Wee Wonderfals book

### Pleated Clutch

Required: • 1 pleated clutch pattern (available day of class) • 1/4 yd fabric for interior • 1/4 yd fabric for exterior, 1/2 yd craft fuse Pellon interfacing • magnetic snap closure

### Yudu Screen Printing

Required: • 1 black and white, high contrast image (no larger than 8.5" x 11").

Students should email image to [studio@theurbancraftcenter.com](mailto:studio@theurbancraftcenter.com) no later than one week before the class. • Materials to print on; t-shirts, fabrics, paper, etc.

### Zipper Front Bag

Required: • 1/2 yd cotton fabric for exterior • 1/2 yd cotton fabric for lining • 1 yd fusible interfacing • 7" Polyester zipper • cotton thread

### Hemming Pants & Jeans

Required: • assorted pants and jeans to hem (no stretchy fabrics please!)

### Intro to Knitting

Required: • 1-2 skeins Lamb's Pride Bulky yarn (any color) • straight knitting needles size 10.5

### Chocolate 101

Optional: • Any molds you wish to take home will be available for purchase day of class, \$3-\$10. Students who don't wish to keep molds can bring their own molds (silicone) or pick up their chocolates once they've cooled beginning the day after the class.

### Colette Dress

Required: • **IMPORTANT NOTE!** We will be making Version 1 with the scoop neck in one solid color without pockets.

Materials to bring-

Colette Crepe Pattern: Pre-purchase the pattern at UCC. Measure your body and choose a size based on the body measurements on the pattern envelope. We will not have time to cut the paper pattern pieces in class, so please cut out the paper pattern pieces A, C, D, F, G, H, I, J, and K in your size.

Fabric: Following your size, bring the suggested amount of fabric marked on the pattern envelope for "shell, version 1". Note that there are different amounts if your fabric width is 45" or 60". If you want to make the waist band in a contrasting fabric, bring 2 yards of that fabric. Please bring medium weight cotton **ONLY**.

Tools: Tailor's chalk or chalk pencil in a color that you can see on your fabric choice.

### T-shirt Workshop

Required: • At least one t-shirt with a rounded neck in your size. No v-necks please!  
Fabric of your choice to make a collar, neck tie, or appliqué. Some fabrics will be offered for you to choose from as well.  
All other materials will be supplied!

### Patternmaking 101

Required: • calculator, roll of scotch tape

### Fat Quarter Bag

Required: • 5 fat quarters (non directional print) • 3 1/2 yards of craft fuse • coordinating cotton thread • (note-please come to class with each fat quarter backed by a piece of craft fuse-you are welcome to come to the class early to do this in the studio ahead of time)

### Cometic Bag

Required: • • 1/4 yard fabric for the exterior of the bag (cotton is best)  
• 1/4 fabric for the lining of the bag (cotton is best) • 9" zipper • thread to match
