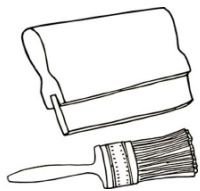

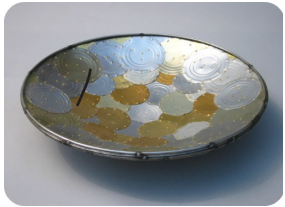
## CROCHET POTHOLDER
