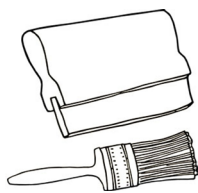

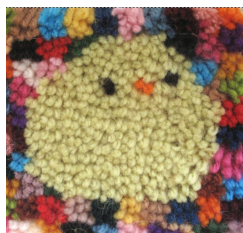
HAPPY CUTE BIRD MINI-RUG
