

# Sweet Yeti Head Ornament

crochet pattern by Cheryl Cambras

## Materials:

Crochet hooks – size H (for head) & size F (for mouth)  
One skein cream bulky weight yarn (for head)  
One skein cream fuzzy lace weight yarn (for head)  
Scraps of red bulky weight yarn (for mouth)  
Scraps of black worsted or bulky weight yarn (for eyes and nostrils)  
Scraps of white felt (for teeth)  
Stitch marker  
Yarn needle  
Hand sewing needle  
Hand sewing thread (red and white)  
Soft stuffing material  
Ornament hanger or twine

## Directions for two-stranded crocheting (for yeti fur):

Hold together one strand of bulky weight yarn and one strand of lace weight fuzzy yarn and crochet the head.

**Head** (use “yeti fur” combo yarn with size H hook) – begin at bottom of head

Slip knot

Ch 3, use sl st to connect 3rd st to 1<sup>st</sup> st, to make a ring

Rnd 1: Sc 6 in center of ring

Rnd 2: \*Inc 1 in each st\* (12 sts); place stitch marker on last stitch and  
cont to place marker on last stitch of every following round

Rnd 3: \*Sc 1, inc 1\* (18 sts)

Rnd 4: \*Sc 2, inc 1\* (24 sts)

Rnd 5: \*Sc 3, inc 1\* (30 sts)

Rnd 6 - 9: \*Sc in each st\* (4 rnds)

Rnd 10: \*Sc 3, dec 1\* (24 sts)

\*\*Embroider face and sew on mouth; stuff head

Rnd 17: \*Sc 2, dec 1\* (18 sts)

Rnd 18: \*Sc 1, dec 1\* (12 sts)

\*\***Finishing head:** Remove stitch marker; add final stuffing; leave a yarn tail of 6 inches; thread yarn needle; tie knot; weave yarn through outside of each of 12 sts; tie knot; pull yarn end through head to hide, and cut.

## Directions to make yeti's mouth with felt fabric:

Decide how large of a mouth you want your yeti to have and cut a circle of red felt. Cut a slightly smaller circle of white felt, fold it in half and cut out teeth. Place the jagged teeth over the red circle and hand sew them together, using the white sewing thread and a small needle. Hand sew the entire mouth onto the yeti's face, using red sewing thread and a small needle.

## Directions to make yeti's mouth with red yarn: (use size F hook)

Slip knot

Ch 3, use sl st to connect 3rd st to 1<sup>st</sup> st, to make a ring

Rnd 1: Sc 6 in center of ring

Rnd 2: \*Inc 1 in each st\* (12 sts); place stitch marker

Rnd 3: \*Sc in each st\*

\***Finishing mouth:** Remove stitch marker; make a slip stitch in final stitch; leave a yarn tail of 6 inches; make a knot in the final stitch. Follow the directions above to add white teeth out of the felt fabric. Thread the the yarn needle with the red yarn tail, bring yarn tail to inside of yeti's head, and secure. Hand sew the finished mouth to the yeti's head with red hand sewing thread and a small needle.

Brush your yeti head with a wire comb or brush to fuzz him up. Attach a loop of twine with a yarn needle or affix a metal hanger to top for hanging. Enjoy!
